ONLINE LEARNING	× No free, full time state-wide programs √ Some public school districts have blended or completely online options
HOMESCHOOL & MICROSCHOOL	✓ Independent, parent-driven education ✓ Funding available through an annual allotment for state-funded correspondence programs ✓ Must provide notice of intent to homeschool only if homeschooling as a religious private school ✓ No specific subject or assessment requirements ✓ Homeschooled students may still be eligible to participate in sports or classes free of charge ✓ Microschools - students gathered in small groups to learn are available
