

SCHOOL CHOICE IN NEBRASKA



TRADITIONAL PUBLIC SCHOOL

- ✓ Free public schools based on your physical address or zone
- ✓ May charge tuition for open enrollment transfers
- ✓ Flexible open enrollment - students can attend any public district in Nebraska
- ✓ Public school districts must post their open enrollment policies on their website
- ✓ Transportation may be available for students eligible for free or reduced lunch, part of diversity focus program, or students with disabilities



PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL

- × Nebraska has not passed laws allowing for the creation of public charter schools



PUBLIC MAGNET SCHOOL

- ✓ Free public schools
- ✓ May have entrance exams or performance auditions
- ✓ Schools have fixed application deadlines



PRIVATE SCHOOL

- × No state funding is available for private school tuition
- ✓ Other scholarship options may be available from schools or nonprofits



ONLINE LEARNING

- × No free, public online programs available
- ✓ Private, tuition-based online options are available
- ✓ Some public school districts have their own online programs



HOMESCHOOL & MICROSCHOOL

- ✓ Independent, parent-driven education
- ✓ Must provide notice of intent to homeschool
- ✓ Annual information survey and parent representative form required
- ✓ Specific subjects must be taught
- ✓ Standardized assessments are not required
- ✓ Microschools - students gathered in small groups to learn are available
