PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL	 ✓ Free public schools ✓ Must take any student who applies if there is a seat available - including students with disabilities ✓ Schools have fixed application deadlines ✓ If applications exceed available seats, a lottery is held
PUBLIC MAGNET SCHOOL	 ✓ Free public schools ✓ May have entrance exams or performance auditions ✓ Schools have fixed application deadlines
PRIVATE SCHOOL	 ✓ Scholarships funded by donors who receive tax credits are available for students meeting income eligibility requirements ✓ Other scholarship options may be available from schools or nonprofits
ONLINE	 ✓ Free, full-time online learning program available ✓ Some public school districts have their own online programs ✓ Virginia students are required to take at least one online course or blended learning experience to graduate
HOMESCHOOL & MICROSCHOOL	 ✓ Independent, parent-driven education ✓ Four legal options: home instruction, homeschooling with religious exemption, homeschooling with a certified tutor, or homeschooling under a private school ✓ Notice of intent to homeschool may be required ✓ No specific subjects must be taught ✓ Standardized assessments may be required ✓ Microschools - students gathered in small groups to learn are available
